Scott County Regional Authority Awards Over \$1.5 Million
bringing total funding since 1991 to \$82.8 Million

The Scott County Regional Authority (SCRA) announced today awards of over \$1.5 million for the spring 2018 grant cycle.

The Authority received a total of 112 requests for funding totaling \$2,728,489. A total of \$1,530,162 was awarded to 73 projects benefiting residents of Scott County.

This brings SCRA funding since 1991 to \$82,871,541 for the benefit of people and organizations in our community.
